St. Paul's Senior Homes & Services will hold their annual St. Paul's LUV Gala on Saturday, August 27 to celebrate more than 50 years of serving San Diego seniors. The historic evening, "LUV Gala in Paradise," will take place at the Hilton San Diego Resort & Spa in Mission Beach. Mark and Barbara DeMichele will be recognized for their outstanding service to St. Paul's and the greater San Diego community.
