St. Paul's PACE participants receive tailored medical care from the finest professionals who specialize in aging and chronic conditions. Our medical team works with therapists, dieticians, social workers, and home care nurses to create a customized care plan for each St. Paul's PACE participant to ensure optimal health, safety, and well-being.

Participants receive all health care including primary and specialist services (other than emergency services) from St. Paul's PACE or a contracted provider authorized by St. Paul's PACE. Participants may be fully and personally liable for the costs of unauthorized, out-of-network services.



St. Paul's PACE provides coordinated medical and social services to seniors who wish to continue living in their own home despite chronic health needs. For many, it is a welcomed alternative to a nursing home. A wide-range of services includes (but is not limited to):

Medical Care

- Primary and specialty care
- Dentistry, podiatry, and optometry
- Prescription medication
- Outpatient labs and X-rays
- Emergency and urgent care
- Long-term care
- Dietary support

In-Home Assistance

- Personal care such as bathing/grooming
- Light housekeeping
- Help with grocery shopping

Ongoing Rehabilitation

- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech therapy
- Durable medical equipment

Transportation

- To and from St. Paul's PACE center
- To and from medical appointments

Social Work

• Ongoing supportive case management

Day Center

- Recreational therapy including music, art, exercise, and field trips
- Three-course lunch

Services provided are per an individualized care plan and approved by the St. Paul's PACE Care Team.



St. Paul's PACE serves adults 55 and older with medical conditions who:

- Need special care and assistance to remain living safely in their home
- Meet the Skilled Nursing Level of Care requirements as determined by the California Department of Health Care Services
- Can live in the community without jeopardizing their safety

St. Paul's PACE is a managed care health plan. We accept Medi-Cal, a combination of Medi-Cal and Medicare (dual eligible), or private payment. For those with Medi-Cal and no share-of-cost, St. Paul's PACE services are FREE. There are no co-pays or hidden fees; even medications are FREE (pending aid code approval).

Medi-Cal beneficiaries who have a share-of-cost remain responsible for their individual share-of-cost. Participants without Medi-Cal pay a monthly premium to cover long-term care and Medicare Part D drugs.
